Congratulations! You are about to finish Module 1 of the UNICEF/Ohio University Learning Course on Communication for Development (C4D). Before moving on to Module 2 (which begins May 13th), we have a few reminders for you.

### End-of-module test:

When Module 1 ends on Sunday, May 5th, you can proceed to the final component --the end-of-module test. The test will be accessible for a period of TWO WEEKS, closing on Sunday, May 19th). You do not have to do the test in a single sitting you can save your work and return to the test at another time. Because this gives you time to review readings and discussions, as needed, only one test attempt is allowed.

You need to earn a minimum of 48 out of the 60 available marks on the Module 1 and 2 tests (worth 30 marks each) to receive an invitation to the workshop at the School of Public Health at the University of the Witwatersrand in Johannesburg, South Africa (August 4-16, 2013).

At the end of each module we will send an online evaluation survey. There will be a link at the end of each end-of-module test, and we will also send a link through Ning and/or email.
